The Friends of Seney National Wildlife Refuge is celebrating National Wildlife Refuge Week with wildlife refuges across the country by participating in a national event, **Walk for the Wild**, on Saturday, October 12 at Seney National Wildlife Refuge. Registration will begin at 9:30, and the walk will begin at 10:00 a.m.

The walk is free and open to everyone. It's a great opportunity to support wildlife conservation, connect with the great outdoors, and boost physical and mental well-being. A win-win!

The walk will begin at the Northern Hardwoods trailhead on Robinson Street in Germfask, where walkers can choose a 5k adventure loop through a beautiful forest, or the more accessible/wheeled Pine Creek/Otter Run route, which will take walkers over Upper Goose Pen Pool and along the edge of A Pool. The walk is open to everyone and is a free event. There is also a virtual option for people who want to walk at a different place, day or time. A donation option and the ability to create your own fundraising team on behalf of Seney NWR is available on our team page.

This is a fun walk! The event is not timed, and there will be treats at the finish line. Dressing like your favorite "wild thing" is encouraged! Participants can join in a BioBlitz and kids can earn a Junior Ranger badge while completing the walk route. Details will be available at the Northern Hardwoods trailhead on walk day.

Join us in raising awareness of America's Wildlife Refuges and the beauty of our UP Seney National Wildlife Refuge complex, which includes 95,000 acres near Seney plus Whitefish Point and several island refuges. The Walk for the Wild 5K helps demonstrate our commitment to deepening human connections with nature and protection of the thriving ecosystems we depend on.
